

International SAAB-Club Meeting 2017 in Dinslaken/Germany

PRE-TOUR Preliminary Program (as of 23.05.2017)

Tuesday, 01.08.2017

The tour starts at 8.00 am in Rostock at the ferry harbor. After the ferry from Trelleborg has arrived, the participants who booked this ferry will be received at the port exit. This is also the meeting place for all other participants, who travel from the North-East of Germany to the pre-tour.

We will then go directly to Rostock, where you can have calm breakfast. From there the tour is going relaxed towards Rerik, where you can visit the pier and let the wind blow around your nose. At noon we do continue towards "Schloss Bothmer" in the "Klützer Winkel". Next to the visit to the castle there is also lunch available.

The pre-tour participants, who arrive with the ferry at 1.15 pm in Rostock on Tuesday, can go directly to the Castle of Bothmer and join the pre-tour.

In the afternoon we will drive to Lübeck, where we will stop in the evening South of Lübeck.

Wednesday, 02.08.2017

We start our first day trip after breakfast. This takes us from Lübeck via to Lauenburg, where we will cross the river Elbe. We continue to Scharnebeck. There we can visit the ship lift.

After a short trip we will arrive in Lüneburg. There is much to discover here: Water tower, town hall or simply sit in a nice pub and enjoy the old town. There will be something for everyone. At 4.30 pm we will head to the last stage of the day towards Walsrode. In the evening a joint dinner is possible.

Thursday, 03.08.2017

After breakfast we do continue our pre-tour. We will drive via the country and mainly through small villages towards Minden and on to Lemgo. There we will visit the largest private Porsche museum in Germany, "der kleine Lemgoer". In the afternoon we will take a small stage to Bielefeld and stop at the "Lenkwerk". Here we can strengthen ourselves with coffee and cake for the last daily stage to Münster.

In the evening a joint dinner with the local Saab-Club Münster in the hotel is possible.

Route: approx. 227 km, pure driving time approx. 4 hrs 45 min

After breakfast, we do meet at the Schlossplatz in Münster at 11:30 am (large parking lot in the city center directly in front of the castle) and take a long walk in the old town of Münster.

Afterwards, we will head to Dinslaken through the countryside (trying to avoid the crowded highway on a Friday afternoon) to the event area of the Int-Saab 2017.

Route: approx. 95 km, pure driving time approx. 1 hrs. 30 min

The fee for each participant over 12 years is 20€. In particular, it is intended to cover general organizational expenses and to limit cost risks. Possible surpluses will go to the Saab Museum in Trollhättan / Sweden. All costs for hotels, meals, visits ... have to be paid by the participants themselves.
